

Gate Installation Instructions

It is the responsibility of the installer to meet or exceed all code and safety requirements and to obtain all required building permits.

These instructions are only a guide and may not address every circumstance. The installer should determine and implement appropriate installation techniques for each situation. Always use the proper safety equipment recommended for the machinery or product you are using when installing our railing.

Step 1 - Prepare Mounting Surfaces

- a. Install and prepare posts to which your gate will be installed.
- b. Make sure you have installed the railing before installing your gate.

Step 2 - Assembly

- a. Unwrap & lay pieces on flat surface.
- b. Insert pickets into bottom rail.
- c. Complete picket assembly and add top rail.
- d. Adjust picket on each side to leave room for insertion of the rails into the sleeves.
- e. Insert top & bottom rail into gate sockets on both sleeves. Push together tightly and lay gate on flat surface.
- f. Measure the width of the gate to make sure it will fit correctly in between both posts in the opening of the railing.
- g. When you're sure the gate will fit with ease, insert two screws through gate pocket (on top and bottom) and into rail.
- h. Do this on both the top and bottom rail.
- i. You are now ready to install your cap. With PVC cement or SILICONE caulk, use a small amount on the inside lip of the cap and mount in place.
- j. Add hardware and accessories.
- j. Your job is now complete. Should your railing have any loose dirt on it from the installation, hose it off or wipe with a soft cloth. To remove any stubborn dirt or stains refer to our website.
